Duration and Attendance

The Master will last for a total of four or seven months and will be divided into two terms. The first month will consist of tuition, followed by an internship of a minimum of three to six months.

The course will run from October 5th to November 1st 2016.

Classes will be held in **English**. The programme is full-time, Monday to Friday from 9am - 6pm (with one hour lunch break).

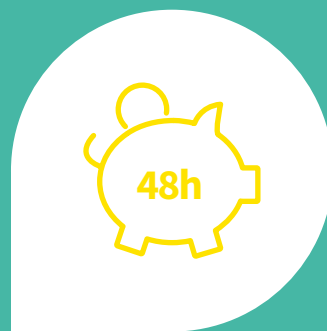

Admission

To apply candidates should:

fill in the English CV and send it to master@italchamind.org.uk; **submit the online application form**;

Once the application has been received, the Chamber will contact the candidate via email to arrange a telephone interview with one of our English native speakers in order to assess the candidate's command of the language. After that the candidate will be informed about success of their application and the possible grant of one of the scholarships. The deadline for submitting applications is when the maximum number of participants has been reached. Considering that there are a limited number of places, the Italian Chamber of Commerce for the UK reserves the right to accept or reject applications.



Students must attend at least 75% of lectures.



There is a final written test which ends the first theoretical part of the Master



Certificate

To be granted the Master certificate, students must attend at least 75% of lectures.

The final written test ends the first theoretical part of the Master. It is made up of open-ended questions and its aim is to test how much the students have understood during the lectures. The students will not receive a mark.
